## 6-Year Program

Cultivating Potential across the Nation

Our **6-Year Program** is a hybrid college and career success program for **11th graders** from across the country designed to support Scholars on their journey from high school into high-trajectory careers. During their first two summers, Scholars will participate in six-week **residential** Summer Academy sessions on university campuses.

### Minimum Eligibility

- Must be in **11th grade** in a high school in the U.S.
- You identify as an underrepresented student, including **first generation** college goers, **students of color**, and students from **under-resourced communities**
- Unweighted GPA is **3.6+**
- Family income does not exceed **\$125,000** annually



## Thrive Academies

Los Angeles/ New York City/ Chicago

Our **Thrive Academies Program** is a **two-year** college preparation program for **11th graders**, currently offered to students based in **Los Angeles, New York, and Chicago**. Scholars will participate in two **commuter** Thrive Academy summer sessions hosted on a local college campus.

### Minimum Eligibility

- Must be in **11th grade** in a high school in the **Chicago, Los Angeles or New York City** metropolitan areas
- You identify as an underrepresented student, including **first generation** college goers, **students of color**, and students from **under-resourced communities**
- Unweighted GPA is **3.6+**
- Family income does not exceed **\$125,000** annually



## OnRamp

Cultivating Potential in Black Males

**OnRamp** is a hybrid **10-month** pre-college initiative for **10th grade Black/Generational African American males** (*defined as the descendants of enslaved people in the United States*) from across the country offering 1-on-1 high school success coaching and a six-week residential Summer Academy on a university campus.

### Minimum Eligibility

- Must be in **10th grade** in a high school in the U.S.
- Identify as an **African American male**
- Unweighted GPA is **3.4+**
- Family income does not exceed **\$125,000** annually
